DIRECT SPEECH

QUOTATION

Bij Direct Speech wordt exact herhaald wat een persoon op een bepaald moment heeft gezegd. BELANGRIJK: Eerst leestekens, dan aanhalingstekens.

VOORBEELD

She said: "I think BLIJLES Bollenstreek is a fantastic company."

PRESENT SIMPLE

She said: "It's cold."

PRESENT PERFECT

She said: "I've lived here since 1999."

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

She said: "I'm teaching English."

PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS

She said: "I have been teaching.

PAST SIMPLE

She said: "I taught English."

PAST PERFECT

She said: "I had lived here."

PAST CONTINUOUS

She said: "I was teaching."

PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS

She said: "I had been teaching.""

In de Indirect Speech gaat de werkwoordstijd een stapje terug (behalve Past Perfect en Past Perfect Continuous), omdat je iets beschrijft wat al is gebeurd. Je mag 'that' gebruiken, maar dit is niet verplicht.

INDIRECT SPEECH

REPORT

Bij Indirect Speech wordt ongeveer beschreven wat een persoon op een bepaald moment zou hebben gezegd. Vaak verandert dan de werkwoordstijd.

VOORBEELD

He said that he was going to the cinema this afternoon.

PAST SIMPLE

She said it was cold

PAST PERFECT

She said she had lived here since 1999."

PAST CONTINUOUS

She said she was teaching English.

PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS

She said she had been teaching.

PAST PERFECT

She said she had taught English.

PAST PERFECT

She said she had lived here."

PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS

She said she had been teaching."

PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS

She said she had been teaching."
